Admissions Process

Step 1: Complete and Submit the Application Form: available at:
<https://fiatclassicalacademy.org/admissions-process/>.

Submit Application Form which includes Academic Records and the Handwritten Essay, by mail to address below with a \$50 check made payable to *Fiat Classical Academy* which is a non-refundable application fee. *

***Priority deadline: The application fee is waived if application is received (or postmarked) by January 8, 2024**

Step 2: Interview with student and parents

- a. You will be contacted by Fiat Classical Academy (FCA) within two weeks of applying to schedule the interview. The above-mentioned documents (see Step 1) will need to be received by FCA before scheduling the interview.
- b. As part of the interview families (parents and student) will be asked to consent to support the Mission and Vision of Fiat Classical Academy.

Step 3: Complete the Admissions Process

- a. A letter of acceptance will be sent after all of the above is reviewed, processed, and accepted by Fiat Classical Academy.
- b. Submit Registration Fee of \$200 to be a Fiat Classical Academy student for the 2024-2025 inaugural year!

Step 4: Register to take the CLT 8 (this can be completed at any time in the admissions process)

- a. The purpose of the CLT 8 is placement and planning, it is not an entrance test. Go to the following website to register for the CLT 8 <https://www.cltexam.com/tests/clt-8/> . You will be required to sign up for an account as an individual to take the test online at home proctored by a parent and then share the results with FCA. The cost will be \$39.00 (payable through your CLT account).
- b. Also, you will find on the CLT website a downloadable Sample Test with answers to practice for the CLT 8.
- c. Offered March 5th, 2024. Registration deadline is Feb. 29th. There will be an additional CLT8 offered from April 22-May 17, 2024.

Admissions Policy and Procedures

Priority Deadline for Admissions:

1. Applications for students entering 9th or 10th grade in 2024 are to be submitted online or postmarked by Monday, January 8th.
2. Students who apply by the deadline will be included in the first group of acceptance decisions and will be notified by Feb. 16th of their acceptance status.
3. Students who submit complete applications for 9th or 10th grade after January 8th will be considered if space allows and will be notified sometime after the Feb. 16th decisions are made.

Factors in Admissions Decisions

Prospective students will be admitted primarily on their desire and ability to grow spiritually and academically at Fiat Classical Academy. Fiat Classical Academy does not discriminate against applicants and students on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

Tuition, Vouchers, and Financial Aid

1. Tuition for the 2024-2025 school year is \$7,750, which includes the application and registration fees.
2. The Indiana Choice Scholarship Program, commonly known as the voucher program, was established to provide every Indiana student access to the school that best meets their learning needs. The Choice Scholarship awards funds to qualified students to help pay tuition at the non-public school of their choice.
