Admissions Packet 2025-2026

Priority Deadline for Admissions

1. To meet the priority deadline, student applications must be received (or postmarked) by Monday, December 16, 2024.
2. Students who apply by the priority deadline will be included in the first group of acceptance decisions and will be notified by January 31, 2025 of their acceptance status.
3. Students who submit an application *after* December 16, 2024 will be considered if space allows and will be notified sometime after the January 31, 2025 decisions have been made.

Tuition and Choice Scholarship (voucher)

1. Tuition for the 2025-2026 academic year will be set by the Board of Directors by the end of 2024. As a point of reference, the cost of tuition for the 2024-2025 academic year was \$7,750. The \$200 non-refundable enrollment fee will be deducted from the cost of tuition.
2. Fiat Classical Academy is an accredited high school in the state of Indiana. All of our students who reside in Indiana and meet the basic requirements receive the Choice Scholarship, commonly known as the “voucher”. The amount awarded per student for 2024-2025 ranged approximately from \$6,100-\$6,600.

Factors in Admissions Decisions

Prospective students will be admitted primarily on their desire and ability to grow spiritually and academically at Fiat Classical Academy. Fiat Classical Academy does not discriminate against applicants and students on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

Admissions Process

Step 1: Submit your complete application to Fiat Classical Academy, consisting of the following:

- The Student Application below, which includes your son/daughter's handwritten essay.
- Your son/daughter's academic records (see the application for details).
- Your \$50 non-refundable application fee. Make checks payable to *Fiat Classical Academy*. **Note: Priority deadline: The fee is waived if your application is received (or postmarked) by Monday, December 16, 2024.**
- Mail all of the above items to:

Step 2: Parent and student interview:

- After all of the above items have been received, within two weeks you will be contacted by Fiat Classical Academy to schedule your interview.
- As part of the interview, parents and students will be asked to consent to support the mission and vision of Fiat Classical Academy.

Step 3: Acceptance letter, financial aid and official enrollment:

- A letter of acceptance and an enrollment tuition contract will be sent to you after all of the above is reviewed, processed, and accepted by Fiat Classical Academy.
- If you indicated on your student application that you are in need of financial aid, then you will be given a financial aid application before being invited to enroll. Those who submit an application by the priority deadline of December 16 will receive first priority in receiving financial aid.
- Within two weeks of receiving your letter of acceptance, submit the \$200 non-refundable enrollment fee (deducted from tuition) and completed enrollment tuition contract to officially enroll your son/daughter as a student of Fiat Classical Academy!
