Admissions Packet 2026-2027

Priority Deadline for Admissions

- To meet the priority deadline, student applications must be received (or postmarked) by **January 9, 2026**.
- Families who apply by the priority deadline will have their application fee waived. They will be included in the first group of acceptance decisions and will be notified by February 6, 2026 of their acceptance status.
- Families who submit an application *after* January 9, 2026 will be considered if space allows and will be notified sometime after the February 6, 2026 decisions have been made.

Tuition, Choice Scholarship, Financial Aid, and Carpooling

- The Board of Directors has not yet set tuition for the 2026-2027 academic year. For context, tuition for the 2025-2026 academic year is \$8,375. The \$200 non-refundable enrollment fee will be deducted from the cost of tuition.
- Fiat Classical Academy students who reside in Indiana and meet the eligibility requirements receive the Choice Scholarship (“voucher”). The amount awarded per student for 2025-2026 ranges approximately from \$6,200-\$6,700.
- All families may apply for financial aid by completing the application through TADS, a third party company used by Fiat Classical Academy. Simply indicate it on your student application below, and we will provide you with directions. The deadline to be in the first pool of applications is **January 30, 2026**. Then, you will be notified of your financial aid award amount by February 27, 2026.
- Many of our students carpool. To help you coordinate carpooling with other families in your area, ask for our carpooling document, available upon request.

Factors in Admissions Decisions

Prospective students will be admitted primarily on their desire and ability to grow spiritually and academically at Fiat Classical Academy. Fiat Classical Academy does not discriminate against applicants and students on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

Admissions Process

Step 1: Submit your complete application to Fiat Classical Academy, consisting of the following:

- The student application (below), which includes your son/daughter's handwritten essay.
- Your son/daughter's academic records (see the application for details).
- Your \$50 non-refundable application fee. Make checks payable to *Fiat Classical Academy*. ***Note: Priority deadline: The fee is waived if your application is received (or postmarked) by January 9, 2026.***

Step 2: Parent and student interview:

- After all of the above items have been received, you will be contacted by Fiat Classical Academy within two weeks to schedule your interview.
- As part of the interview, parents and students will be asked to consent to support the mission and vision of Fiat Classical Academy.

Step 3: Acceptance letter, financial aid and officially enroll:

- A letter of acceptance and directions to enroll will be sent to you after all of the above is reviewed, processed, and accepted by Fiat Classical Academy.
- If you indicated on your student application that you are in need of financial aid, then you will be given directions to complete the TADS financial aid application before being asked to enroll. Those who submit their student application by the priority deadline of January 9, 2026 will receive first priority in receiving financial aid.
- Complete the Tuition Agreement through TADS and submit the \$200 non-refundable enrollment fee (deducted from tuition) to officially enroll your son/daughter as a student of Fiat Classical Academy!
