



Important Admissions Dates

September 28, 2026 – Shadow Days begin

November 5, 2026 – Open House from 5:00-8:00pm

December 14, 2026 – Deadline for priority admissions applications

January 4, 2027 – Deadline for priority financial aid applications

January 29, 2027 – Notification given to priority admissions and financial aid applicants

March 1, 2027 – Deadline for current families to re-enroll current student or enroll new student for priority admission

General Admissions Information

Priority Deadline and Waiting List

- To meet the priority deadline, applications must be received by Fiat Classical Academy (or postmarked) by **December 14, 2026**.
- Families who apply by the priority deadline will have their \$50 application fee waived. They will also be included in the first group of acceptance decisions and will be notified by January 29, 2027 of their acceptance status.
- Families who submit an application *after* December 14, 2026 will be considered if space allows and will be notified sometime after the January 29, 2027 decisions have been made.
- Waiting list: Once we reach 15 students per grade level we will begin a waiting list in order to assess class size feasibility. Students who apply and are accepted *after* we have reached 15 students will be added to the waiting list, in a first come first serve order. Additionally, admissions priority will be given to families who either have a child currently enrolled or a son or daughter who is an alumni.

Affordable Tuition and Carpooling Options

- 100% of our current students received one or more forms of tuition assistance. Every family who has applied has found it affordable.
- Fiat Classical Academy students who reside in Indiana receive the Choice Scholarship (“voucher”). The amount awarded per student for 2026-2027 ranges approximately from \$6,400-\$6,900.
- All families may apply for financial aid by completing the application through TADS, a third party service used by Fiat Classical Academy. Simply indicate your need for financial aid on your application, and we will provide you with directions. The deadline

to be in the first pool of financial aid applications is **January 4, 2027**. You will be notified of your financial aid award amount by January 29, 2027.

- Tuition for the current academic year is \$9,045. The \$200 non-refundable enrollment fee will be deducted from the cost of tuition. The Board of Directors has not yet set tuition for the 2027-2028 academic year.
- Many of our students carpool. To help you coordinate carpooling with other families in your area, ask for our carpooling document, available upon request.

Factors in Admissions Decisions

Prospective students will be admitted primarily on their desire and ability to grow spiritually and academically at Fiat Classical Academy. Fiat Classical Academy does not discriminate against applicants and students on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

Admissions Process

Step 1: Submit your complete application to Fiat Classical Academy, consisting of the following:

- The application (below), with the optional student essay.
- Your son/daughter's academic records (see the application for details).
- Your \$50 non-refundable application fee. Make checks payable to *Fiat Classical Academy*. ***The fee is waived if your application is received (or postmarked) by the priority deadline of December 14, 2026.***

Step 2: Parent and student meeting:

- After all of the above items have been received, you will be contacted by Fiat Classical Academy to schedule your meeting.
- As part of the meeting, parents and students will be asked to consent to support the mission and vision of Fiat Classical Academy.

Step 3: Acceptance letter, financial aid and officially enroll:

- A letter of acceptance and directions to enroll will be sent to you after all of the above is reviewed, processed, and accepted by Fiat Classical Academy.
- If you indicated on your application that you are in need of financial aid, then you will be given directions to complete the TADS financial aid application before being sent your Tuition Agreement to enroll.
- Complete the Tuition Agreement through TADS and submit the \$200 non-refundable enrollment fee (deducted from tuition) to officially enroll your son or daughter as a student of Fiat Classical Academy!
